

## 29th Annual Presque Isle Spring Walleye Tournament May 14-16, 2021 Rules

- This will be a catch and release tournament. Fishing hours are 12pm to 8pm Friday, 7am to Noon and 3pm to 8pm Saturday, and 7am to 11am Sunday
- Awards will be for the total number of inches of walleye registered for all three days. Trophy awarded for longest fish of the tournament. No fish under 12 inches can be registered.
- Each Angler will receive 6 tickets each day with their number to record their catch. Only 5 fish per person each day will count toward the award total.
- The 6<sup>th</sup> ticket can be used as a bonus ticket (like a mulligan in golf) to replace any one of the fish already registered. One bonus ticket per day.
- Each fish must be registered by smart phone and emailed by phone to [info@presqueisle.com](mailto:info@presqueisle.com) or texted to **715-321-4489**
- Photo of the entire walleye being measured with the Angler number on your bump board showing the length of the walleye to ¼ inch.
- Release on the water after taking the photo and then emailing it to [info@presqueisle.com](mailto:info@presqueisle.com) or texting it to **715-321-4489**
- Each Angler should also keep a record on your tally sheet to keep track of your walleye registered so there are no discrepancies.
- All fish registered by phone at Walleye Tournament base will be recorded on a master tally sheet and fish photos and tally sheet will be compared for accuracy.
- No fish will be recorded before or after tournament fishing hours.
- Not responsible for photos that are not clearly depicting the whole fish measurement.
- Presque Isle Area Lakes listed below can be fished. Someone in your boat must have a cell phone capable of transmitting photos of fish.
- In case of a tie: Single largest fish of the tied anglers will determine the winner.
- Tournament Lakes: Annabelle, Big, Birch, Crab, Harris, Horsehead, Little Crab, Little Horsehead, Lynx, North Crab, North Turtle, Oxbow, Presque Isle Chain (Averill, Presque Isle, Van Vliet), Rock, Round, South Turtle, Wildcat.

Prize Money: \$200 1<sup>st</sup> Place, \$100 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, \$50 3<sup>rd</sup> Place, \$25 4<sup>th</sup>& 5<sup>th</sup> Place
